U.S National Sovereignty About to Be L.O.S.T?

The debate over the United Nations' Law of the Sea Treaty, which will give the UN control over all of the world's oceans that includes 70% of the earth's surface if ratified by the U.S Senate in an upcoming vote, is coming to a boiling point.

Opponents believe that it "blatantly takes away our rights to free movement and private enterprise, and endangers our national sovereignty and independence".

The treaty creates an International Seabed Authority, which has the power to tax private enterprise in the form of application fees and royalties. Additionally it has the authority to mine the seabed in competition with free enterprise, with subsidies from the member nations.

More than twenty years ago, then President Regan not only refused to sign, but actually fired the U.S State Department staff that had negotiated it. L.O.S.T recently resurfaced in 2004 under the sponsorship of Sen. Richard Lugar and was defeated by then Senate Majority Leader Bill Frist.

President Bush stated that the initiative for reintroduction of the treaty comes from the military, which prefers the 12-mile territorial limits it places on national claims to waters. Sen. Lugar and other supporters claim new agreements reached in 1994 under President Clinton resolved the treaty shortcomings cited by President Regan. Also that it will protect U.S interests while safeguarding natural resources.

In a statement issued by Tom DeWeese, President of the American Policy Center, he states "The tangle of international agreements to be policed by the Law of the Sea Treaty leads on to be wary of a new report by the U.S Commission on Ocean Policy which calls for new federal regulations to affect oceans and coasts. The Commission's report calls for an "eco-system management approach that goes far beyond the political boundaries like state lines" to strengthen the link between coastal and watershed management. Such language is straight out of the U.N's Biodiversity Treaty".

Update/Correction On REAL ID ACT OF 2005

In the Sept edition of this publication it was stated that the effective date for enforcement of the Act was May 2009 which should have been printed as 2008. But recently the Dept of Homeland Security extended the time for States to comply, all licenses and identification cards must be compliant by May 10, 2013. After that date you will not be able to travel on a common carrier aircraft along with other serious restrictions unless you possess an ID that meets DHS specified requirements. Possible Alternative to Oil Dependency Discovered/Cancer Treatment

As sure as death and taxes it is more than certain that the price of oil will continue to spiral upward. Recently a retired TV station owner and broadcast engineer, John Kanzius who was looking for a cure for cancer by injecting patients with tiny bits of specific metal nano-particals, then heating them with radio-waves which made them attractive to abnormal cancer cells, destroying them and leaving health tissue. Vigilant Shield 08—Martial Law Drill Conducted In U.S

On 5 September 05 [The United States Northern Command \(USNORTHCOM\) announced plans for an anti-terrorism exercise called Vigilant Shield 08](#). The exercise began on October 15th and ended on October 20th. The exercise was described as a way to prepare, prevent and respond to any number of national crises. Also described as simply a test case scenario for the implementation of martial law.

Although the mainstream press did not report on the exercise, many who were aware of it found the description of the exercise disturbing. By conducting this exercise USNORTHCOM states that this will make them better prepared for a natural disaster and a terrorist attack also adding that the response in New Orleans after Hurricane Katrina, during which, authorities confiscated citizen's personal firearms and even relocated people against their will, was considered a test laboratory.

These announcements, according to Lee Rogers, a contributing writer for Intel Strike Forum, "are incredibly disturbing on a number of levels as the nature of Vigilant Shield 08 and the admission that Hurricane Katrina was used as a test laboratory shows that the government is actively preparing the military and government institutions for martial law". Many cite the statement by the Bush administration which released a directive called the [National Security and Homeland Security Presidential Directive](#) for their main concern. In this directive, Mr. Bush declares that in the event of a "Catastrophic Emergency" the President will be entrusted with leading the activities to ensure constitutional government.

Mr. Rogers also states "The language written in the directive is disturbing because it doesn't say that the President will work with the other branches of government equally to ensure a constitutional government is protected. It says clearly that there will be a cooperative effort among the three branches that will be coordinated by the President. If the President is coordinating these efforts it effectively puts him in charge of every branch".

The following is a full press release from USNORTHCOM describing Vigilant Shield 08:

North American Aerospace Defense Command and U.S. Northern Command along with U.S. Pacific Command, the Department of Homeland Security as well as local, state and other federal responders will exercise their response abilities against a variety of potential threats during Exercise Vigilant Shield '08, a Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff-designated, North American Aerospace Defense Command (NORAD) and U.S. Northern Command (USNORTHCOM)-sponsored, and U.S. Joint Forces Command-supported Department of Defense exercise for homeland defense and defense support of civil authorities missions.

VS-08 will be conducted concurrent with Top Officials 4 (TOPOFF 4), the nation's premier exercise of terrorism preparedness sponsored by the Department of Homeland Security, and several other linked exercises as part of the National Level Exercise 1-08. These linked exercises will take place October 15-20 and are being conducted throughout the United States and in conjunction with several partner nations including Australia, Canada, and the United Kingdom, as well as the Territory of Guam.

VS-08 and National Level Exercise 1-08 will provide local, state, tribal, interagency, Department of Defense, and non-governmental organizations and agencies involved in homeland security and homeland defense the opportunity to participate in a full range of exercise scenarios that will better prepare participants to prevent and respond to national crises. The participating organizations will conduct a multi-layered, civilian-led response to a national crisis.

USNORTHCOM's primary exercise venues for VS-08 include locations in Oregon, Arizona and a cooperative venue with USPACOM in the Territory of Guam. NORAD's aerospace detection and defense events will take place across all the exercise venues, to exercise the ability to mobilize resources for aerospace defense, aerospace control, maritime warning, and coordination of air operations in a disaster area.

Malignant Tumors In Lab Animals May be Linked to Microchip Implants

There is no doubting the value of any device such as a microchip, that will re-unite a lost pet and its human care provider (formerly referred to as a owner). But several weeks ago the Associated Press released a story citing a series of research articles which covered more than a decade of study that found that mice and rats injected with glass-encapsulated RFID transponders developed malignant, fast-growing lethal cancers in up to 1% to 10% of cases. The tumors originated in the tissue surrounding the microchips and often grew to completely surround the devices according to the research papers released to the AP. One very well know microchip producer who received FDA approval in 2004 to implant the devices in humans claims the company was "not aware of any studies that have resulted in malignant tumors in lab rats, mice and certainly not dogs or cats".

Defenders of the microchip, many being veterinary medical researchers expressed the belief that the supposed chip-induced tumors may be flawed, because the animals used were genetically predisposed to cancer.

Recall of Military Commissary Items

Baker's Premium White Chocolate Baking Squares

Commissaries worldwide have pulled from their shelves Baker's Premium White Chocolate Baking Squares (6-oz) because the product may be contaminated with salmonella. The recall only affects Lot# UPC 0043000252200 with the expiration dates: March 31, 2008; April 2, 2008 and April 3, 2008. Consumers can contact Kraft Consumer Response at 1-800-310-3704. Commissary patrons who have this product at home should return the unused product with the label to the location it was purchased from for a full refund.

Recall Update of Ground Beef

The Defense Commissary Agency (DeCA) has updated the name of one of the frozen ground beef products pulled from its stores as part of the Topps Meat Company, LLC voluntary recall. Agency food safety officials have identified and pulled from its shelves Mike's 20 Seasoned Beef Patties. The products subject to recall bear the establishment number "Est 9748" inside the USDA mark of inspection as well as a sell-by date between "SEP 25 07" and "SEP 25 08". Pacific Servicemembers to Receive Flu Vaccine

Stars and Stripes reports that U.S. military health officials across Japan and Okinawa say influenza vaccine shipments are arriving and their base clinics and hospitals soon will receive their allotments. Shortages are not expected. A big change this flu season is that U.S. servicemembers and civilians ages 2 to 49 will receive vaccine in the form of a mist, similar to a nasal spray. Flu vaccinations are mandatory for U.S. servicemember. Vet Commission endorses significant Pay Gains and Sweeping Reforms

The first time in 51 years a comprehensive review of veterans' disability benefits has been conducted and recommends that [Congress](#) and the Bush administration support an [immediate increase in compensation levels](#) – of up to 25 percent for the most severely disabled – to recognize monetarily their reduced quality of life. Disabled veterans and their families will find much to be pleased about in the report's 113 recommendations, assuming lawmakers and VA follow through on sweeping reforms presented in the report. It might take Congress years to implement the bulk of the commission's proposals but it should view some as priorities including:

Concurrent Receipt --

Ending the ban on [concurrent receipt](#) for all disabled military retirees and all service members who have been separated due to service-connected disabilities. .

End SBP-DIC offset --

The dollar-for-dollar reduction in military [survivor benefit](#) that occurs when surviving spouses also draw VA Dependency and Indemnity Compensation should end.

Raise VA Compensation --

[VA disability compensation](#) should be boosted immediately by as much as 25 percent.

PTSD: A Holistic Approach --

Disability compensation for [post-traumatic stress disorder](#) with treatment and vocational assessment.

Update Rating Schedule --

The 60-year-old disability rating schedule should be revised starting with post-traumatic stress disorder, other mental disorders and traumatic brain injury.

IU Status --

Veterans with disabilities rated 60 to 90 percent can still get compensation at the 100 percent level if deemed unable to work.

PANDEMIC! – Is It A Real Threat And Are You Ready?

For quite sometime now we have been hearing from media sources that we need to prepare ourselves for the inevitable "Pandemic" and from government websites such as www.pandemicflu.gov or www.avianflu.gov. Even with all the information available it seems that no one source can tell us exactly what to prepare for because it is not certain precisely what type of flu strain we will be dealing with. In addition to having to worry about a deadly strain of flu we also have to content with methicillin-resistant *Staphylococcus aureus* (MRSA),

A recent study published in the *Journal of the American Medical Association* estimates that MRSA infections occurred in nearly 95,000 Americans in 2005. Based on those figures, an estimated 18,650 people died due to their MRSA infection in 2005. That death rate is higher than the HIV/AIDS death rate for that year, and the number of MRSA related deaths is much higher than previously thought..

How do we combat this threat to our health? Research carried out at University College Hospital London discovered that dry steam applied at temperatures ranging from 150-180 degrees C could destroy bacteria, including antibiotic resistant superbugs like MRSA, in less than two seconds. Researchers from Oxford Catalysts, a English company, is currently in the development stages of a hand-held device that creates instant steam in seconds by passing alcohol and hydrogen peroxide through a fine powder catalyst, which can produce steam at temperatures up to 800 degree C, but can produce cooler steam suitable for hospital cleaning. The powder catalyst is the size of a sugar cube. Once the alcohol and hydrogen peroxide mixture comes into contact with the powder, it causes a powerful reaction, producing steam and carbon dioxide. Tests and development of the units are ongoing.

Until these units are successfully developed and on the market, the following may help in avoiding MRSA

Wash hands thoroughly with soap and water or with alcohol-based hand sanitizer.

- Be sure to keep cuts and scrapes clean and bandaged.
- Avoid contact with other people's cuts, scrapes and bandages.
- Do not share personal items like bath towels.
